2.4. HANDICAP SYSTEM: PHRF

- **3. RULES:** This *Event* will be governed by US Sailing 2013-2016 RRS as modified by the MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.
- **3.4** Children under 12 years of age shall wear PFDs at all times. Yachts are required to check-in with the signal boat prior to the start.
- 4. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: None
- **5.3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be posted on Regatta Management Solutions, website www.regattaman.com and the CPYC website, www.cpyc.org
- **6.1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE:** At Cottage Park Yacht Club and VHF radio channel 72
- **7.1 SCHEDULE of RACES:** 15 races over the season divided into 3 series, five evenings each. At least one race an evening.
- **7.2. START TIME:** The first warning signal will be made at 1830 hrs. The first warning signal in September will be at 1800 hrs. The class starts will be announced using the appropriate code flag, however, the order will be A fleet followed by B fleet. A and B may sail different courses as noted on the course board.
- 9. RACING AREA: Start in the vicinity of Yellow Nun "E", 1+ miles west of Deer Island Light.
- **10.1 THE COURSE:** Courses using marks from Cottage Park Yacht Club Wednesday Night Racing Mark List will be designated by letters displayed by the race committee signal boat. Marks shall be rounded, and the finishing mark passed, in the order displayed.
- **10.3 (d):** If a green flag or placard "S" is displayed by the race committee signal boat, all turning marks shall be rounded to starboard; otherwise a green color or the letter "S" associated with an individual turning mark letter, will indicate starboard rounding for that mark, and a red color, or letter "P" associated with the turning mark, will indicate port rounding. **In the absence of any indications all marks shall be left to port.**
- **10.4:** All racing vessels are requested to stay clear of the starting line until 5 minutes before their start.

In addition while waiting to start, all racing vessels are requested to stay clear of the Winthrop Ferry Channel, between RN "6" and GC"7", GC"5" and GC "3" and RN "4". All vessels are reminded that the Winthrop Ferry has the right of way.

- **12.1 MARKS:** Cottage Park Yacht Club Wednesday Night Racing Mark List available at www.cpyc.org or attached. The Race Committee boat may also have copies available.
- **14.2 RECALLS:** The race committee will use the VHF Channel 72.
- **17.1 & 17.2 TIME LIMIT:** The time limit for each class shall be two hours. The Finishing Window will be 30 minutes after the first boat finishes in each class.
- **20. SCORING:** The low point system will be used. There are no throw-outs. Rumbles may or may not be included for the series. Boats will be scored using either their cruising or racing handicap based on their declaration to the RC before the race. Boats using spinnakers MUST fly an "R" flag to be scored with their racing rating.

24. PRIZES:

- **24.1** Prizes will be awarded for first place in each class for the Spring, Summer, Late Summer series.
- **24.2**. Prizes will be awarded for three places in each class for the overall season.
- **24.3** Prizes will be presented at CPYC Annual Awards Night to be held in conjunction with Mass Bay Sailing Awards dinner at CPYC on Friday, November 21, 2014.

ADDITONAL INSTRUCTIONS: Each boat must identify itself by coming within hailing distance of the Race Committee signal boat prior to the beginning of its class starting sequence, but not within five (5) minutes of the start of the prior class state to check in, report the number of souls on board and declare whether they are racing spinnaker or J&M.

All sailors are invited to the Cottage Park Yacht Club Pilot House following the evening racing.

Dates for Rumble I, II and III are denoted by stared dates. Separate Sailing Instructions will be issued for Rumble starting orders, location and scoring.
