10.4: All racing vessels are requested to stay clear of the starting line until 5 minutes before their start. In addition while waiting to start, all racing vessels are requested to stay clear of the Winthrop Ferry Channel, between RN "6" and GC"7", GC"5" and GC "3" and RN "4". All vessels are reminded that the Winthrop Ferry has the right of way.

12.1 MARKS: Cottage Park Yacht Club Wednesday Night Racing Mark List available at www.cpyc.org or attached. The Race Committee boat may also have copies available.

14.2 RECALLS: The race committee will use the VHF Channel 72.

17.1 & 17.2 TIME LIMIT: The time limit for each class shall be two hours. The Finishing Window will be 30 minutes after the first boat finishes in each class.

20. SCORING: The low point system will be used. There are no throw-outs. Rumbles may or may not be included for the series. Boats will be scored using either their cruising or racing handicap based on their declaration to the RC before the race. Boats using spinnakers MUST fly an "R" flag to be scored with their racing rating.

24. PRIZES:

24.1 Prizes will be awarded for first place in each class for the Spring, Summer, Late Summer series.

24.2. Prizes will be awarded for three places in each class for the overall season.

24.3 Prizes will be presented at CPYC Annual Awards Night to be held in conjunction with Mass Bay Sailing Awards dinner at CPYC on Friday, November 21, 2014.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: Each boat must identify itself by coming within hailing distance of the Race Committee signal boat prior to the beginning of its class starting sequence, but not within five (5) minutes of the start of the prior class state to check in, report the number of souls on board and declare whether they are racing spinnaker or J&M.

All sailors are invited to the Cottage Park Yacht Club Pilot House following the evening racing.

Dates for Rumble I, II and III are denoted by stated dates. Separate Sailing Instructions will be issued for Rumble starting orders, location and scoring.

Additional Information

1. If a boat chooses to fly its spinnaker, it must declare it is doing so before the start of the race **and by flying the designated streamer (available from the RC) or the "R" flag** from their back stay to be scored properly (i.e., before the Warning Signal).
2. Boats racing with spinnakers **and flying the designated streamer** or "R" flag will be scored with their racing rating in the race.
 - i. Additionally, a boat flying the designated streamer or "R" flag will be scored using their racing rating if they chose not to fly a spinnaker after the start.
 - ii. A boat that does not fly the designated streamer or "R" flag and uses a spinnaker during the race will be disqualified and scored as DSQ.
 - iii. Boats that do not display the streamer or "R" flag and do not fly a chute will be scored using their cursing rating.
