Schedule of Races

One race is scheduled

Start Time

• First gun at 1600 hours

Starting Line

• Hingham Bay Starting Buoy (200yd N Of Sheep Is.)

Finish Line

• Hingham Bay Starting Buoy (200yd N Of Sheep Is.)

Time Limit

• Must finish by 2000 Hours

Course

- Island(s) to be circumnavigated will be listed by fleet on the committee boat.
- Boats start in the direction towards the gate (2 green tetrahedrons) and must round one of the gate marks before beginning the listed islands.
- The listed islands may be circumnavigated in either direction and in any order.
- After completing the listed islands, all boats will pass between the committee boat and the starting pin in either direction (providing the

RC an opportunity to shorten course), then complete an additional circumnavigation of Peddock's Island.

- Boats may pass between the committee boat and starting pin in either direction to finish the race.
- Participants are reminded to observe the restricted areas listed in the MBSA General Sailing Instructions.

Rules

• Races will be governed by the MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as modified herein or by the Race Committee

HINGHAM

Classes

- This race will be scored under PHRF-NE Handicaps, using Time-on-Time scoring with a correction factor of 550.
- Classes will be in accordance with to MBSA class splits.
- Be mindful that multiple classes may share the same start sequence dependent on the number of entrants.

Flags

• Yachts shall fly their class flag from the backstay.

Race Committee

- The RC will monitor channel 68.
- Yachts must notify the RC if withdrawing.
