

Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

CYC Summerset Regatta

Sunday, June 12, 2016

Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club

- 1.1 Event: Corinthian Yacht Club (CYC) Summerset Regatta, Sunday, June 12, 2016.
- 2.1 Eligibility: Boats with valid current PHRF ratings are eligible for "spinnaker" and "jib&main" classes.
- 2.2 **Registration:** Enter on line at www.regattaman.com/calendar.php no later than 0945 EDT on the day of the event; or file an entry form with Corinthian Yacht Club Race Committee, 1 Nahant St., P.O. Box 401, Marblehead, MA 01945, accompanied by the entry fee, no later than 1800 EDT on the day before the event; paper entries received thereafter may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee (RC).
- 2.3 Fees: The entry fee is \$45 with a \$5 discount for US Sailing members, and/or \$5 discount for MBSA members. A boat may enter this event, CYC's Midsummer Ocean Race and Marblehead Chowder Cup for a package fee of \$100 with a \$10 discount for US Sailing members, and/or \$10 discount for MBSA members; but the package fee will be available only in advance of this event.
- 2.4 Handicaps: Will be PHRF Time on Distance.
- Rules: This Event will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.
- 4 **Notices to Competitors:** Will be posted on the official notice board located in the hallway near the trophy room of the CYC and by E-mail to addresses supplied when registering. There is no Skippers Meeting.
- 5 **Scratch Sheets:** To see a list of boats entered please visit the Regattaman site (item 2.2). The RC may have a few paper scratch sheets (reflecting entries at the time of printing) available to be handed out on the water.
- 6.1 **Signals Made Ashore:** Will be displayed on the yardarm of the CYC Flagstaff.
- 7.1 **Schedule of Races:** The RC intends to run two races using MBSA Standard Courses, with the second race starting shortly after the finish of the first race.
- 7.2 **Warning Signal:** The first Warning Signal will be made at 1100 EDT.
- 9 Racing Area: Start will be in the vicinity of Tinker's Rock Gong, MBSA List A, Mark D.
- 10.1 The Course: The RC intends to use MBSA Standard Courses.
- Marks: If using MBSA Standard Courses, the RC intends to use orange or green tetrahedrons and a black band attached to an orange or green tetrahedron for a change mark; if the mark is changed again, it will be without the black band. Otherwise see MBSA Lists A & B for descriptions and locations
- 14.2 **Recalls:** The RC will use VHF channel 72.
- 17.1 **Time Limit:** Three (3) hours after each class start for MBSA Standard Courses, otherwise five (5) hours after each class start.
- 23.1 Radio Communication: The RC will monitor VHF Channel 72 from 1000 EDT until all yachts have finished. Emergency conditions should be reported to the RC on that channel. The CYC Dockmaster will monitor VHF Channel 9.
- Prizes and social activities: Trophies will be awarded in each class with at least two (2) competitors. Second place trophies will be awarded in each class with at least six (6) competitors. Additional trophies will be awarded for each six (6) additional competitors in a class. The Walter E. Knight Interstate Challenge Cup will be awarded for best overall performance, and a trophy will be awarded for best performance by a CYC boat. The hospitality of the club is extended to all skippers, their crews and guests, to participate in the trophy presentations and social activities.
