EVENT SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, [MBSA Notice of Race and General Sailing Instructions](#) *except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions*.

The Phil Small Race is an O - Ocean Race series and M - PHRF Marblehead series.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by registering online and paying the \$50.00 entry fee. Member discounts are \$5 for US Sailing and \$5 for MBSA. Entries must be submitted before 0900 on Saturday, August 5, 2017. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

All JYC racing season pass holders are entitled to race at half price, \$25 before discounts, and must register to enter at <https://www.regattaman.com>.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the Jubilee Yacht Club Racing website, www.jycracing.org.

4 RADIO USE and ANNOUNCEMENTS

Any changes to the race schedule or cancellations will be announced at 0900 on VHF 72.

Race Committee will monitor VHF 72 from 0900 until one hour after racing ends for the day.

Please refrain from hailing the Race Committee during the starting sequences.

Please check-in by sailing past the stern of the RC boat prior to the first warning signal.

5 SCHEDULE

The first warning signal will be at 1100 Saturday, August 5, 2017. One race is scheduled.

Awards and festivities will follow racing.

6 CLASS FLAGS

Classes will start in the following order:

Flag A = PHRF A (up to 55)

Flag B = PHRF B (56-100)

Flag C = PHRF C (101-155)

Flag F = PHRF Cruising F (JAM up to 155)

Flag D = PHRF D (156 and up)

Flag G = PHRF Cruising G (JAM 156 and up)

Class Starts may be combined at the discretion of the race committee. Monitor VHF 72.

7 RACING AREA

The Racing area will be in the vicinity of Salem Bay with the start in the vicinity of G13, Curtis Point. However any marks on the MBSA or inflatable marks may be used as a start.

The Race Committee may hoist the Lima "follow me" and move the start as needed.

Please monitor VHF Ch. 72 for the location of the start in case the RC boat moves to an alternate starting location.

8 COURSE, MARKS, STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The marks of the course shall be MBSA Standard Rounding Marks, Lists A & B, or MBSA Standard Courses, using inflatable marks. List B: Salem Bay is the most likely list of marks to be used. The course shall be indicated in the RC boat signal rack. The starting and finishing lines will be between the flag on the JYC RC boat and the nearest mark. The Race Committee will attempt to hail premature starters on VHF 72. Failure to hail will not be cause for redress.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit shall be **three hours from the start** of each class. If no boats in a class finish within the time limit then the race shall be abandoned for that class. The time limits may be extended by the Race Committee on VHF 72.

Any yacht that has not finished **within 45 minutes after the first yacht** in its class to finish will be scored OTL (Over Time Limit) and will be given a finishing position one lower than the last boat to have finished within the time limit. This alters RRS 35 and A4. If there are yachts still racing, the Race Committee will announce the expiration of the time limit via VHF 72. The Race Committee may extend any time limits at its discretion.

10 PROTESTS

Competitors intending to protest must inform and be acknowledged by the finish boat within 10 minutes following their finish as an additional requirement of protest filing. This addition changes RRS 61.

Protests shall be delivered to Jubilee Yacht Club Regatta Committee Office within **1 hour** after the RC boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board outside the Regatta Committee Office on first floor. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing at the Jubilee Yacht Club.

11 SCORING

The Low point scoring system will be used. Time on Distance with PHRFNE handicaps will be used to compute corrected times. One Race shall constitute a Regatta. Prizes will be awarded for First and Second place in each class.

Social Activities

All captains, crew and guests are invited back to the Jubilee Yacht Club following the race for a post race party and the awards. Tickets for the party are \$8 per person if purchased in advance and \$10 at the party. Each ticket includes food and three beers.
