



Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions
CYC Midsummer Ocean Race
Sunday, July 15, 2018
Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club

- 1.1 **Event:** Corinthian Yacht Club (CYC) Midsummer Ocean Race, Sunday, July 15, 2018.
- 2.1 **Eligibility:** Boats with valid current ORR-ez ratings are eligible for "spinnaker" and "jib&main" classes.
- 2.2 **Registration:** Enter on line at www.regattaman.com/calendar.php no later than 11:00 on the day of the event; or file an entry form with Corinthian Yacht Club Race Committee, 1 Nahant St., P.O. Box 401, Marblehead, MA 01945, accompanied by the entry fee, no later than 18:00 on the day before the event; paper entries received thereafter may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee (RC).
- 2.3 **Fees:** The entry fee is \$50 with a \$5 discount for US Sailing members, and/or \$5 discount for MBSA members.
- 2.4 **Handicaps:** Will be Time on Time under ORR-ez. Before the first warning signal the RC will announce, on VHF Ch. 72, the projected wind range (based on the RC's current knowledge) that will be used for computing corrected times, i.e., "light" (less than 8 knots) or "medium" (8 to 15.9 knots) or "heavy" (16 knots or more), and it will not be changed during or after a race.
- 3 **Rules:** This Event will be governed by MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.
- 4 **Notices to Competitors:** Will be posted on the official notice board located in the hallway near the trophy room of the CYC and by E-mail to addresses supplied when registering. There is no Skippers Meeting.
- 5 **Scratch Sheets:** To see a list of boats entered in this event please visit the Regattaman site (item 2.2). The RC might have a few paper lists (reflecting entries at the time of printing) available on the water.
- 6.1 **Signals Made Ashore:** Will be displayed on the yardarm of the CYC Flagstaff.
- 7.1 **Schedule of Races:** The RC intends to run a single race.
- 7.2 **Warning Signal:** The warning signal for the first race will be made no earlier than 1230.
- 9 **Racing Area:** Start will be in the vicinity of Tinker's Rock Gong, MBSA List A, Mark D.
- 10 **Courses and Marks:** The RC intends to use MBSA Standard Rounding Marks Lists A & B.
- 14.2 **Recalls:** The RC will use VHF Ch 72.
- 17.1 **Time Limit:** Five (5) hours after each class start.
- 23.1 **Radio Communication:** The RC will monitor VHF Ch 72 from 10:00 until all yachts have finished. Emergency conditions should be reported to the RC on that channel. The CYC Dockmaster will monitor VHF Ch 9.
- 24 **Prizes and Social Activities:** Trophies will be awarded in each class with at least two (2) competitors. Second place trophies will be awarded in each class with at least six (6) competitors. Additional trophies will be awarded for each six (6) additional competitors in a class. The L.R. "Bus" Moulton Performance Trophy will be awarded for the best overall performance, the Commodore N. Nash Trophy will be awarded for the winner in Class A, and the CYC Race Committee Trophy will be awarded for the winner in Class B. The hospitality of the club is extended to all skippers, their crews and guests, to participate in the trophy presentations and social activities.
