NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the International Thunderbird Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Thunderbird Class that are members in good standing of their local Fleet or the ITCA.

4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee will be \$250 US dollars.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration will be Tuesday July 30, 2019 from 1800 hrs till 2100 hrs and Wednesday July 31, 2019 from 1500 hrs till 1730 hrs.

5.2 Measurement and Inspection:

5.2 (a) Boat weighing will be as arranged in accordance with launching for all visiting boats.

5.2(b) Sail measurement will be Tuesday July 30, 2019 from 1800 till 2100 hrs and Wednesday July 31, 2019 from 1500 hrs till 1730 hrs.

5.2(c) A time to be determined will be made available for the Fleet 5 boats to be weighed and sails measured within 60 days of the regatta. This will streamline the process the week of the event



6 Schedule of races.

6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the practice race will be 1830 hrs Wednesday July 31, 2019. The practice race will be sailed in Dorchester Bay.

6.2 The warning signal will be 1100 each scheduled day of racing. The schedule is Thursday August 1, 2019 - Sunday August 4, 2019. There are 11 races scheduled.

6.3 The amount of races each day will be the discretion of the race Committee. It is anticipated that no more than 4 races per day will be sailed.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The sailing instructions will be available after July 28, 2019 on the Web and at the registration on Tuesday July 30, 2019.

8 VENUE

8.1 Savin Hill Yacht Club is located at 400 Morrissey Blvd., Dorchester, MA 02125. Phone 617-825-1108.

8.2 The racing area will be in Quincy Bay.

9 THE COURSES

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward, Leeward. The courses may consist of 2, 3, 4, or 5 legs

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.1 and 44.2 will apply.

10.2 Appendix T and V will be in effect

11 SCORING

11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

12 BERTHING

12.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at Savin Hill YC.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS



13.1 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the judges committee.

14 PRIZES

14.1 Prizes will be given as follows: Prizes shall be given out for the top three finishers in the regatta. There will also be a prize for each race winner.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 US dollars.
