



Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

Corinthian Yacht Club Bandit Short Handed Race

Sunday, October 3, 2021

Mass Bay Short Handed Championship Qualifier Event*

- 1. Rules:** This Event will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions and rules for short handed races except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions. .

- 2. Eligibility:** Boats with valid current ORR-ez ratings are eligible for "spinnaker" and "jib&main" divisions.
- 3. Registration:** Enter online at www.regattaman.com/calendar.php no later than 10:00 on the day of the event. Entries received thereafter may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee (RC).
- 4. Fees:** The entry fee is \$50 with a \$5 discount for US Sailing members, and/or \$5 discount for MBSA members. .
- 5. Handicaps:** Will be Time on Time under ORR-ez. Before the first warning signal for the first race of the day, the RC will announce, on VHF Ch. 72, the projected wind range (based on the RC's current knowledge) that will be used for computing corrected times, i.e., Light or Medium or Heavy.
- 6. Rules:** This Event will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.
- 7. Notices to Competitors:** Will be posted on the official notice board at www.regattaman.com and at the notice board located in the hallway near the CYC trophy room. There is no Skippers Meeting. For a list of entrants and notices please visit www.regattaman.com.
- 8. Signals Made Ashore:** Will be displayed on the yardarm of the CYC Flagstaff. When the AP signal is displayed ashore, the WARNING for the race will not be less than 60 minutes after the lowering of the AP signal. Competitors shall monitor VHF channel 72 for announcements.
- 9. Schedule of Races:** The RC intends to run a single race using government marks.
- 10. Warning Signal:** The warning signal for the first race of the day will be made at 12:30. Code Flag "A" is designated as the class flag for the Spinnaker Division. Code Flag "B" is the designated class flag for the J&M Division.
- 11. Racing Area:** Start will be in the vicinity of Tinker's Rock Gong, MBSA List A, Mark D.
- 12. Courses and Marks:** The course will use government marks taken from the MBSA Standard Rounding Marks, Lists A and B. A portable **Green** mark may be used as a first mark, in which case a **Green** flag will be displayed.
- 13. Recalls:** The RC will use VHF channel 72 to attempt to advise individual boats that are OCS. Failure to hear will not be grounds for redress.
- 14. Time Limit:** four (4) hours after each class/division start.
- 15. Radio Communication:** The RC will monitor VHF Channel 72 from 11:00 until all yachts have finished. Emergency conditions should be reported to the RC on that channel. The CYC Dockmaster will monitor VHF Channel 9.
- 16. Prizes and social activities:** First place trophies will be awarded in each division J&M/Spinnaker with three (3) or more boats. Second place trophies will be awarded in each division with at least six (6) competitors. The hospitality of the club (subject to MA covid restrictions) is extended to all skippers, their crews and guests, to participate in the trophy presentations and social activities. Complementary chowder will be offered.
