**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The Cottage Park Yacht Club Regatta to Benefit Make-A-Wish will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021 – 2024*.
- 1.2. The class rules of the Rhodes 19,, Snipe, Star classes will apply except STCR 31.1.3 does not apply.
- 1.3. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 1.4. Each competitor will be responsible for his or her boat being in compliance with the class rules. The class rules will be used, except that RRS 60.1(a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership or imposing a weight limit.
- 1.5. Competitors shall bring their own boats, dollies and tow boat, etc.

**2. ELIGIBILITY - Eligible classes are: Rhodes 19, Snipe, Star and Sonar classes**

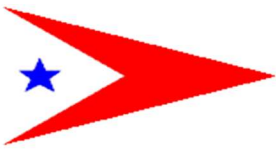

  - 8.1. Marks of the course shall be inflatable drop marks and/or government marks.
  - 8.2. The courses will be Windward/Leeward, Olympic or Triangle courses.
9. **SCORING** – The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. As many races as possible will be scheduled. One (1) race qualifies as a series. If six or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded.
10. **PRIZES** – Make-A-Wish trophies will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in all divisions.
11. **DISCLAIMER** - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
