



NOTICE OF RACE

2021 N10 Open

August 3rd and 4th 2021

Cottage Park Yacht Club

1. RULES

1.1. The 2021 N-10 Open Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021 – 2024*. The rules of the N-10 class will also apply.

1.2 By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority, the Cottage Park Yacht Club and the National Ten Association, the right to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped, videoed or filmed and other productions of him or her without compensation.

2. DISCIPLINE

2.2. All competitors are expected to maintain proper conduct throughout the event. When a Protest Committee, from its own observation or a report received from any competitor that believes that another competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under RRS 69. Protests will be discouraged; however, if the Protest Committee sees or hears of a potential breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, it may call a hearing.

2.3. Hearings will be held in accordance with the recommendations of the Racing Rules of Sailing. The officers for hearing a violation will consist of the Chief Judge, acting as chairman of the hearing, and the Protest Committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1. Current registered member of the N10 Association. Each boat must display a 2021 N-10 decal. Skipper and crew must be under the age of 18 on the days of the regatta. Crews are REQUIRED

3.2. There will be **two Fleets**, a **Championship Fleet**, and a **Green Fleet**. Green Fleet is for beginner sailors only. For N-10 Green, neither the skipper nor the crew may have previously skippered an N-10 in the Championship Fleet of an N-10 Association scheduled regatta.

4. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES

4.1. Advanced registration is preferred but not required. Completed registration forms must be submitted during registration on August 2nd or 3rd. The registration fee is \$100.00 per boat or \$50 a sailor, and includes: T-shirts for sailors, lunches, Wednesday dinner for sailors and coaches and adult hospitality. There is a \$10 late entry fee for registering the day of the regatta.

7.1. Racing will be in the waters of Winthrop Bay along the Westerly side of the CPYC.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 The penalties are as follows: 1 turn for hitting a mark; 2 turns for fouling a competitor.

10. SCORING

10.1. The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply.

10.2. One race shall be completed to constitute a series. If six or more races are completed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded. There is a maximum of 12 races.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

11.1 Will be identified

12. PRIZES

12.1. Trophies will be awarded for the top five finishers, skipper and crew in each fleet.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision on Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damaged or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
