**1 RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available before 1200 on August 8, 2022 on [Regattaman.com](http://Regattaman.com)

**3 COMMUNICATION**

3.1 The online official notice board is located at [www.Regattaman.com](http://www.Regattaman.com)

3.2 All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF channels 9, 16, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, and 78. Race communications will use VHF channel **78**.

3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio channel **78**.

3.4 From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

**4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

4.1 The event is open to all keelboats over 20'.

4.2 Boats entering PHRF Racing (spinnaker) or Cruising (main & jib) classes must have a valid PHRF certificate. Contact GMORA Fleet Handicapper, Don Logan, [dlogan@maine.rr.com](mailto:dlogan@maine.rr.com) to obtain a rating.

4.3 Boats without a PHRF certificate may petition for one for this event by contacting the Registrar/Scorer. A temporary rating may be developed for your boat.

4.4 One-design boats shall comply with the requirements of their class. EtcHELLs may use electronic navigation aids, modifying their Class Regulations.

4.5 All boats shall comply with Federal and State safety requirements.

4.6 Eligible boats must enter by registering online at [www.Regattaman.com](http://www.Regattaman.com).

4.7 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

4.8 To be considered a One-design class, six (6) or more boats must be registered before 1200 on Monday August 8, 2022.

## 5 FEES

### 5.1 Entry fees are as follows:

The registration fee for all boats is \$100 prior to August 6, 2022, \$125 thereafter.

### 5.2 Other fees:

All boats are **EXPECTED** to fundraise or donate at least \$250 to benefit SailMaine prior to race day. As an inducement for your fundraising efforts, we are offering the following PHRF rating adjustments if contribution is made by 1200 August 11, 2022:

*For a contribution of this amount to SailMaine: We will favorably adjust your rating by:*

<b>\$1000</b>	<b>3 sec/mile</b>
<b>\$1500</b>	<b>6 sec/mile</b>
<b>\$2000</b>	<b>9 sec/mile</b>
<b>\$3000</b>	<b>12 sec/mile</b>
<b>\$5000</b>	<b>15 sec/mile</b>

## 6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Registration takes place on Regattaman by 2359, Thursday August 11, 2022.

6.2 Pre-race reception to be held Friday August 12, 2022 at Portland Yacht Services starting at 1730, Skippers Meeting begins at 1800, Pizza and Beverages provided. 400 Commercial St., Portland.

6.3 Dates of racing and number of races:

6.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1230.

6.5 Post-race festivities will occur at Portland Yacht Services beginning at 1730 with Awards at 1800.

## 7 VENUE

7.1 Saturday's racing starts between Fort Gorges and Fish Point. The courses will encompass the shipping channel, central turning basin, and return to Fish Point.

## 8 THE COURSES

8.1 The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. Approximate course lengths are included.

8.2 The marks that may be used are as follows, marks left to port unless labeled starboard:

Race "A" Start – OJ – CK – CS – YA (stbd) – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 14.1 nm

Race "B" Start – OG -CK – CS – YA (stbd) – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 11.6 nm

Race "C" Start – CV – CK – CS – YA (stbd) – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 10.1 nm

Cruise "D" Start – OJ – N – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 11.3 nm

Cruise "E" Start – OG – N – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 8.8 nm

Cruise "F" Start – CV – N – CJ (stbd) – E – YC (stbd) – Finish 7.3 nm

8.3 Modification to the courses or shortening courses shall be described in the SIs.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

9.1 The One-Turn and Two-Turn Penalties will be in effect.

9.2 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, will not apply.

## **10 SCORING**

10.1 The scoring system is as follows: Appendix A.

10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute an event.

10.3 GMORA scoring shall not include rating adjustments provided for your donation efforts.

## **11 RISK STATEMENT**

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees or acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.

## **12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

## **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the top three boats of all classes. Prizes will be based on the corrected finish placing using the adjusted ratings provided prior to the race start.
