

37th Annual *JFK* Regatta A Navigator Race Sailing Instructions

This year the JFK will be a long race to test your navigation skills.

2.1 &2.2 ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY: In accordance with MBSA Season Championship splits.

2.2 **Registration**: Register online at <u>www.regattaman.com</u> Registration before August 10th, \$5.00 discount.

2.3 FEES: \$60. Mass Bay sailing member discount \$5.00. Make checks payable to Cottage Park Yacht Club. **Entries must be received by August 12th.** .

2.4 HANDICAP SYSTEM: ORR-ez Time on Time will be used. ORR-ez certificate

3. RULES: This event will be governed by the MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions, which will be posted on <u>www.cpyc.org</u> and <u>www.regattaman.com</u>.

Boats are required to check-in before their first start of the day by sailing by the stern of the Signal boat. Boats in the racing area that are not starting a second or subsequent race must notify the Race Committee before leaving the racing area. Boats that withdraw from racing must advise the Race Committee as soon as reasonably possible.

4. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS; Notices to competitors will be posted on <u>www.regattaman.com</u>.

5.3 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be posted on www.regattaman.com

6.1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: Signals made ashore will be displayed at CPYC and on VHF 72.

(Should weather dictate abandoning the regatta prior to the rendezvous, or moving the race area, the RC will make an announcement at approximately 1000 hrs. by VHF, Text, and email)

7.1 SCHEDULE OF RACES: 1 race.

7.2 WARNING SIGNAL: First warning signal 1200 hrs.

9. RACING AREA: Rendezvous in the vicinity of MBSA Greater Boston/Hingham Mark 5, President Roads N "E" 1130 hrs.

10.1 THE COURSE: Intended courses to be used are MBSA List of Marks "A" and/or "C". Remember to respect restricted areas as defined by MBSA .

11 MARKS: Marks will be government marks (MBSA List of Marks "A").

13. THE START: MBSA classes A, B, C, D, F, and G will start in that order in accordance with RRS 26. The RC may combine classes based on the number of registered boats.

14.2 RECALLS: The Race Committee will use VHF channel 72.

17.1 TIME LIMIT: 3 hrs. after the actual starting time of each class. The finishing window shall be 30 minutes after the first boat in each class finishes.

19. PROTESTS: Written protests must be filed on the appropriate form and may be submitted by email

within 24 hours to the Fleet Governor at <u>www.regattacomittee@cpyc.org</u> Details of the hearing will then be provided as soon as possible.

20. SCORING: The low point system will be used.

24. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented to three places in class depending on number of entries at CPYC Annual Awards Night to be held in conjunction with Mass Bay Sailing Awards dinner at CPYC on Friday, November 18, 2022. Additionally, the names of first place winners of each class will be added to the Perpetual JFK Trophy at CPYC.
