A pursuit race around the Salem Sound/Marblehead area.

- 1 Event: This is a pursuit type race, in which the slower boats start before the faster boats, with each boat starting at an assigned time, based on their PHRF handicap. There will be two divisions: Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker (JAM). One-Design classes, and others may be added to either division at the discretion of the Race Committee. This race is a qualifier for the MBSA Pursuit Race Series.
- 2 Eligibility: Open to all boats with a valid 2024 PHRF-NE certificate. Classes will be standard Massachusetts Bay Sailing Association classes. One-design classes may be specified at the discretion of the JYC Race Committee provided enough entries are received. No handicap certificate will be required for boats entering a one-design class.
- 3 Registration: Competitors may enter online at <u>www.regattaman.com</u>.
- 4 **Fees:** \$50.00 less \$5 for USSA, and/or less \$5 for MBSA. JYC Thursday Night Season Pass holders receive free registration.
- 5 Handicap System: PHRF Time on Distance will be used.
- 6 **Rules:** The Phil Small Race will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions except as changed by the Phil Small Race Sailing Instructions.
- 7 Notices to Competitors: Notices to competitors will be posted on <u>www.jycracing.org</u>.
- 8 Schedule of Races: One race will be held.
- 9 Race Start Times: Start times will be assigned after registration closes. These will be mailed to skippers electronically no later than 0930 the day of the race and paper copies will be available at the JYC Lounge before the race. The first start will be no later than 1200 hrs. A blue flag will be raised with one sound signal 5 minutes before the start time of the first boat. The Race Committee will attempt to do a countdown for each boat's start, to be broadcast on VHF channel 72, but each boat will be responsible for knowing their start time.
- 10 Racing Area: Salem Sound, starting in the vicinity of Curtis Point.
- 11 **The Course:** Courses will be detailed in the event Sailing Instructions, and made available on the jycracing.org web site no later than one week before the race.
- 12 Marks: If MBSA Standard Courses are used the inflatable marks will be tetrahedrons or cylinders.
- 13 Recalls: The JYC Race Committee will use VHF channel 72.
- 14 Time Limit: The time limit shall be three and one half (3 ¹/₂) hours from the start of the first boat.
- 15 Prizes: Trophies will be presented for the First through Third places in the Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker divisions. First place prize is awarded to the first boat to finish in her class, should such class exist, in each division. A "Good Sport" prize will be awarded.
- 16 Guest Moorings: A limited number of guest moorings are available free of charge, reserved through <u>Dockwa</u>. A visiting regatta racer should indicate that their vessel will be participating in the Phil Small regatta. There will be no charge for the first night, then the regular rate for any nights thereafter. Reservations are first-come-first-served and include use of launches and club facilities. Please hail the launch on VHF channel 78.

Social Activities: As always, skippers, crew, and their guests are welcomed back at the club to participate in the legendary JYC Hospitality.
