

EYC Lambert Overnight Ocean Race SATELLITE RACE TRACKING

Every boat racing in the Lambert shall carry a supported satellite tracking device. One of the reasons for this requirement is safety based on knowing everyone's location in real time.

Eastern YC has purchase a license from Kattack to provide tracking and display of the boats during the Lambert Overnight Ocean race. The race can be followed on a desktop or laptop computer, iPhone, and Android smartphones.

What the skipper needs to do –

1. Send me by email
 - a. For SPOT or InReach – the shared page tracker URL
 - b. For AIS – the MMSI
2. For SPOT or InReach – set to 10-minute intervals
3. Turn on your tracker for 30 minutes within 48 hours prior to the skippers meeting at 1630 hrs. on June 29th, so we can verify they are working properly.
