Bobby Veltman Memorial Race

Sponsored by Eastern Point Yacht Club and The RhumbLine Restaurant Saturday, September 2nd, 2023

10.1 **The Course:** The coordinates of the start line are near Kettle Ledge at 42 32.600 N and 70 41.600 W. All marks will be rounded to port. There will be no off-set marks, nor leeward gates. A change of direction to the next mark can be made at any point by the race committee signaling Code Flag C and broadcasting the new directionnumber of degrees the mark has been moved and in which direction (i.e. "the mark has been moved to the left 10 dregrees") via VHF before the first boat rounds the prior mark. A change in distance from one mark to the next will not be made. In the event of light air, the race committee may shorten the course by signaling Code Flag S, and presenting a finish line between a committee boat and a nearby mark.

Course A - This course will be twice around a standard windward/leeward course. The race committee will broadcast the magnetic direction and approximate distance to GPS coordinates of the windward mark prior to the warning signal via VHF. Both the starting mark and the windward mark will be yellow tetrahedrons.

Course B - This course will be twice around a "modified" windward/leeward course with the start/finish line in the middle of the course. The race committee will broadcast the magnetic direction and approximate distance to GPS coordinates of the windward and leeward marks prior to the warning signal via VHF, as well as the distance from the windward mark to the leeward mark. The starting mark will be an orange ball, and both the windward and leeward marks will be yellow tetrahedrons. After the start, boats not finishing may not pass through the start/finish line.
