



Notice of Series

KHYC 2023 Spinnaker Series



A series of (5) race events hosted by KHYC. The series is a qualifier for the ASMBYC Championships should there be one scheduled for the year, and (4) of the (5) are also ASMBYC High Point Series races.

DIVISIONS: Based in initial registrations, PHRF classes will be established for the entire series using PHRF Area B RLC handicaps. They are based on relative performance potential and anticipated entries. PHRF Spinnaker Class A, B and C assignments will be assigned the day before the first race. PHRF-V class will be available for boats with PHRF WL ratings that are greater than 135 and have Performance Factors that are less than 1.76. Non-spinnaker offsets will not apply.

ENTRIES: Spinnaker classes are open to members of SCYA affiliated Yacht Clubs or Associations who hold a current rating certificate. Cruisers, Multihulls, Martin 242s, Vipers, J70s and other one design classes are invited; at least three entries will constitute a class. One Design and Multihull entries must fulfill the eligibility requirements of their class. Entrants shall complete the online entry process for the desired race in the race series regatta management system website ([race management system shortcuts are here](#)).

The entry fee for individual races is \$35.00 or \$125.00 for the entire series. Early registrants, defined as those who register and pay more than 5 days prior to any race (excluding race day) receive a \$10 discount on individual race fees for each race or a \$25 discount on the series race fee. Single race registration cut-off is 5pm the day before any race.

RULES: This series will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the USSA Prescriptions and the Sailing Instructions issued by KHYC for each race. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions will be available on the regatta management system website ([race management system shortcuts are here](#)).

SCORING: The USSA low point scoring system will apply except that scoring for DNC, DNS, DSQ, etc. will be one place more than the number of starters in each race. Each race will be scored separately toward the lowest series total for 5 races with **one throw out**. PHRF boats must race with a valid certificate, sail in 3 race events and race with their spinnaker rating to qualify for series awards and perpetual trophies.

TROPHIES: There will be individual take home trophies for each event. Perpetual trophies for each race, as noted in the Sailing Instructions will be awarded to the PHRF winner during the annual race awards event. The “Bob Hight Memorial” Perpetual Trophy for Class A, the “The Spinnaker” Perpetual Trophy for Class B and the “Vintage” Perpetual Trophy for Class V are awarded to the overall series winners.

HOSPITALITY: Participants are welcome to use the clubhouse, overnight guest dock and hoist (6000 lbs. Max) in conjunction with each race. Refreshments are offered after the races.

KHYC 2023 Spinnaker Series

Individual Race Descriptions:

No. 1 - Stoney Special, Saturday, March 18th

A race of approximately 10.3 NM using KHYC marks. A US Nearshore event. Random Leg Ratings apply with TOD scoring. An ASMBYC High Point Race.

No. 2 - Trans Harbor, Saturday April 22nd

A race of approximately 22.1 NM using KHYC marks and race marks off Marina del Rey. A US Nearshore event. RLC ratings will apply with TOD scoring. **An ASMBYC High Point Race.**

No. 3 - Malibu and Return, Saturday June 17th

A race across Santa Monica Bay to a mark near the Malibu Pier or if shortened, a virtual GPS mark, and return. A US Nearshore event. RLC ratings apply with TOD scoring. The course to Malibu is 35.5 nm and that to the GPS shortened virtual mark and return is approximately 25 nm.

No. 4 – KHYC to CBYC Saturday August 5th

A race of about 17 NM from King Harbor to Cabrillo Beach via Angels Gate. A US Nearshore event. RLC ratings will apply with TOD scoring.

No. 5 - Matt Walsh, Saturday September 16th

A single multiple leg race of approximately 11.2 NM using both KHYC marks and 10PV. A US Nearshore event. RLC ratings apply with TOD scoring. An ASMBYC High Point Race.
