

2023 South Shore Junior Championships (SSJC)

Organizing Authority: South Shore Junior Championships Committee (SSJCC) is composed of representatives from the clubs on the South Shore of Boston who run Junior regattas and others interested in promoting sail boat racing with junior sailors.

Eligibility: Open to all sailors and clubs who compete in the regattas that make up this series.

Venues: The awards will be based on the results of the following regattas:

- [Hingham Bay Junior Regatta](#) - July 13, 14th
- [Hull Scorpion Bowl](#) - July 20, 21th
- [Lipton Cup Regatta Juniors](#) - July 29,30th
- [Cottage Park YC Make A Wish](#) - Aug 5,6th

Awards: There will be both Individual and Club awards in this Series.

Individual:

- Opti Blue
- Opti White
- Opti Red
- Opti Green(10 yrs or younger)
- 420 Crew
- 420 Skipper

Club:

- Opti
- 420

Trophy's will be presented to the sailors and clubs after the completion of all regattas at a place and time TBD. Prior to that, the current standings will be available at regattaman.com.

Scoring: The scoring of the SSJC awards will be based on the final overall place of each boat as reported to the SSJC by each of the regattas Organizing Authority(OA). Racing Rules of sailing Appendix 9 will be used to determine the results of each award.

SSJC will not accept any requests for redress to change the reported results from the regatta's OA', any of these requests will be referred to the OA's.

Individual: The results of all regattas in the series will be summed together per Low Point Scoring and the boat with the lowest point totals in 3 out of 4 of the regattas will be the winner. Appendix A8 and A7 will apply for breaking ties.

Note: In the 420 skipper and crew trophies the Sailors who change from status from regatta to regatta will not be able to combine their points for the trophy.

Club: The club trophies will be the club with the lowest sum of finish places in 3 out of 4 of the regattas. Points will be awarded per the finish place each boat had against the boats they sailed against. The SSJCC does not impose any restrictions on the OA's class and line assignments. Clubs must qualify by having boats race in 2 of the 3 regattas in the championship to be eligible.

Fees: There is no additional fee required to be scored in this championship.
